

Exploring Rivers

19th, 20th, 26th and 27th September

It's your final chance to experience our amazing Eden River Wonder World exhibition. We're offering a full day session all about the river, including a visit to the exhibition and river dipping on the Eden with Eden Rivers Trust.

£2 per pupil for Member Schools and £2.75 for non-members. This project is supported by Eden River's Trust's Cherish Eden project, funded by Heritage Lottery Fund.

First World War Week

12th to 16th November 2018

Commemorate the 100th anniversary of the end of the First World War and enjoy a full day experience with Tullie House and Cumbria's Museum of Military Life. Explore the life of a soldier, take part in interactive object handling and find out what life was like for Cumbrians during the conflict.

A full day exploring Ancient Egypt, featuring a visit from Inesti an Egyptian Farmers Wife, object handling and craft activity.

Diwali

29th October to 2nd November 2018

To celebrate the Hindu festival of light Priya Sundar will explore Diwali using dance, storytelling and objects from the museum collection.

£125 per half day. Sessions last for 1 hour and can accommodate a class of 35. Subject to school timetable we can fit in 2 sessions per half day.

We Will Remember Them

5th to 9th November 2018

This one hour workshop explores WW1 and remembrance using objects, storytelling and costume and focuses on the story of Poppy and her brother Wilfred.

£110 per half day. Session lasts for 1 hour and can accommodate a class of up to 35. Subject to school timetable we can fit in 2 sessions per half day.

Romans, Reivers and Royalty: 2000 years of history at Burgh By Sands Church

10th to 14th June 2019

In this special 2 hour session history is brought to life through objects, costume and the building itself. The session will focus on chronological skills using example from the church's amazing history.
