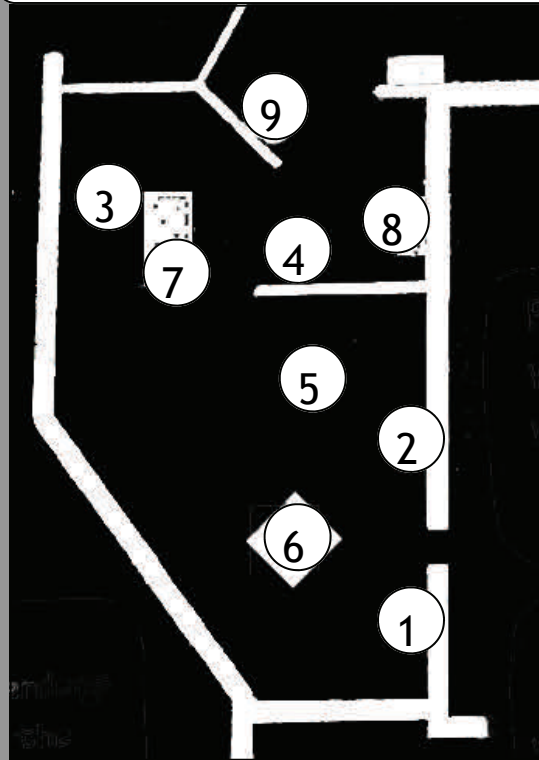

### Lion and Unicorn

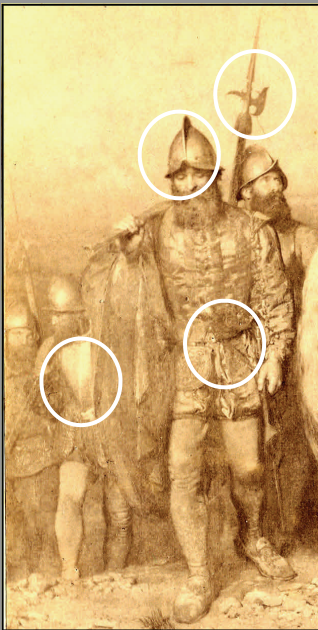
