Inspired by Landscape

During 1799 Turner visited Cumbria as part of his Northern Tour and was inspired to create many beautiful watercolours of the landscapes he encountered.

We are asking pupils to follow in his footsteps and create their own artwork inspired by their favourite local landscape. This could be anything from mountains in the Lakes to a local park or their own back garden. We want them to be inspired by nature in all its forms!

All of the entries will be on display digitally in Tullie House's *Turner: Northern Exposure* exhibition in Autumn 2019. The Top 10 will be framed and hung in the exhibition. The overall winner will receive a hamper of art supplies as well as an invitation for their class to attend a celebration event at Tullie House.

HOW TO ENTER

- The competition is open to primary aged children and all entries need to be made via their school.
- Works should be A3 landscape, with a sentence at the bottom explaining the significance of the landscape chosen.
- Photographs of the works need to be submitted digitally by the 9th September 2019, to schools@tulliehouse.org - please use a file sharing platform if needed. We will email a confirmation once we have received your images.
- The title of each photograph should include – school, name and age of each entrant.
- Please keep the original artwork as we will ask for the top 10 to be sent in to Tullie House by the end of September for display in the exhibition.
- All works submitted will be displayed digitally in the exhibition, alongside the framed top ten.
- The winner will be announced via Facebook Live on Friday 18th Oct
- The winner's class will be invited to Tullie House to attend a celebration event and presentation in Autumn Term 2, including a tour and art workshop.
